

Current Affairs #49—Intro Hidden Manna Series

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I have been doing a series called *The End of the Age*. Now, it has come to the point of focus on prophetic utterances. And I have begun this series where the focus *is* on prophetic utterances. We will be looking at types and shadows. We will be looking at numbers, dreams, and visions—all the ways that God speaks prophetically to people. God laid up these prophetic things in Scripture to be brought out in our time as manna for the day.

Now, you cannot know what prophetic things mean until the time has come for the revealing of those things from heaven. So, if we have had traditional prophetic maps, and charts, and arrows and things pointing in every direction, it is time to lay those things aside because they were conceived in a time prior to the appointed time for the revealing of such things. So they will heavily reference historic events within those time periods. For example, in the days of the Soviet Union, much was said about the Soviet Union as a symbol of prophetic things. There have been various historical figures, even in our time, that people have regarded to be persons to fulfill Scripture, like the anti-Christ, and much speculation about who is the anti-Christ and silliness like that. Much of which, just by the passage of time, has been thoroughly overthrown and totally debunked.

There is a real danger, however, in the fact that these prior prognostications have not held any water, for people to come to the place of thinking that these things are just symbols that no one could understand. Daniel had dreams, John was given visions, and so on, but who can know these things? That is not only foolish, it is dangerous—dangerous to your health, dangerous to your well-being. God laid up these prophetic things to be opened at the appropriate time. And before that time, if you read these prophetic passages, they could not mean anything except what history and the interpretations that lie against the background of history until that time, could mean. It was impossible for people in prior times to envision the days in which we live in. But it was never impossible for God to envision the times in which we would live.

In fact, the book of Revelation was a revelation given to John while he was caught up into heaven, so it was above time and space. The horizons were distant. But as time moved on inexorably, heaven and earth would meet, and our horizon, what used to be the future, would now be the present horizon. In these times a shift has come and with it, different times have come. That is why

we need to go back and revisit prophetic Scripture, not through the lenses of prior speculation and conjecture, but instead through the proven revelation and insights that have been given of recent times because they were leading up to, and providing keys of understanding for, that which God is now unveiling. So, in light of that, it has been my intention to wade into prophetic Scripture.

Prophetic Scripture, at the time of the revelation of these things, is no longer prophetic; it is apostolic. Prophetic is the thing that is yet out in the distance. And I am not saying that none of those things happen, but I am saying these things that are now, used to be the distant future when they were written. But now that they are here, they are no longer prophetic, in the sense of the distant future. So, they are going to be decoded and they are going to be unpacked by the apostolic. These are the helmsmen who steer the ship through these times. The ship is not steered prophetically. The ship is steered apostolically because the rulers and governors of that which God has over the House of God, over the heritage of God, are the apostles. They are the apostolic.

So even though I am wading into prophetic Scripture, it is simply because the time has come for the unveiling of that which used to be distant. If you walk far enough, long enough toward the distant horizon, eventually you will be standing right in the midst of what you saw afar off then. That is what I am saying. And the interpretation of these things for the benefit of the saints, to be translated into policy, what the saints are to do, that has been entrusted into the apostolic guidance of the Body of Christ in this time.

Now, there are other things that will yet be spoken prophetically, and there are aspects of this that are yet to be decoded prophetically. However, the things that are before us are not any longer prophetic; they have come. *This is that*. So in the interest of providing revelation and insight, and by that, guidance, I am wading into prophetic Scripture at the direction, frankly, of the Lord. Obviously, so many things that I have spoken here, I have never spoken before, nor have you ever heard anyone else speak these things before. Why? Not because I am smart or especially gifted or anything like that. It is simply because the time has come, and God was going to speak these things through the mouths (plural) of some group of people alive in the earth at the time that such things had come. I happen to be one of those alive at this time in the earth through whom God means to speak these things. So, my intent is to serve the Body of Christ, to serve as in one presenting to the

Body of Christ, the things that God would have served to them. This is the children's bread, and my hope is that it will strengthen you in these times that are irrevocably changed.
